## The Charge Up! Speakers

### Louis Pang

Louis is an award-winning writer and photographer based in Sabah, Malaysia.

A graduate of the University of Toronto and a former editor of his campus newspaper, Louis' literary work was shortlisted the Toronto Life Rattle writers festival. His photojournalistic work garnered him a bronze prize in the Shell Press Award.



In 2004, Louis left the editorial desk to pursue photography professionally. His corporate clients include the Sutera Harbour Resort, Sabah Tourism Board and the Royal London Circus. Louis covered the 2004 & 2005 Malaysian F1 Grand Prix for the Associated Press. His work has been syndicated by the Associated Press and AFP and appeared in major publications in the region.

Pouring his heart and soul into wedding photojournalism, Louis' talents earned him the membership of Wedding Photojournalist Association (WPJA)—an US-based organization that represents the most talented professional wedding photographers around the world. Less than 5% of photographers qualify for WPJA.

In 2006, Louis was appointed a *Stylus Pro* by Epson who is a world leader in professional digital fine art printing solutions. This prestigious recognition sees Louis writes, speaks and lectures on digital printing and digital photography workflow for Epson.

Today, Louis shoots weddings exclusively. He travels nationally and internationally for commissioned wedding coverage in Malaysia, Hong Kong, Singapore, Thailand and Indonesia. He is also available for destination weddings and engagement shoots around the world. Louis and his wife Jasmine made Sabah their home.
